Baccalaureate Requirements

- Total Degree Credits Required = 120 credits of which a minimum of 36 are Upper-Division Credits (level 3000 and above)
- Completion of Major Requirements (*as indicated above*) ; Completion of General Education Requirements (*as indicated above*)
- Cumulative GPA of at least 2.0; Major GPA of at least 2.0
- Residency Requirements: 12 credits of major coursework and 24 of the last 30 credits immediately preceding graduation (*Serviceember's Opportunity College students, please see your academic advisor*)
