We will then try our best to schedule students to their first choices but this is not always possible due to clashing or closed classes, so students must always state alternative modules on their application. Students attending RACL will receive their

Please describe the application process for incoming exchange students:	<p>Partner institution will need to complete the Nomination Chart via email to <a href="mailto:inbound@regents.ac.uk">inbound@regents.ac.uk</a> by 15 March 2013 (Autumn) and 30 September 2013 (Spring).</p> <p>Students will then need to submit the documents detailed above before the application deadline. The IPO will send out acceptance letters to the home institution by 1st June (Autumn) and by 15th December (Spring).</p>

What is the process for obtaining a visa to study at your program?	The IPO is not able to advice on visas or visa applications.
