

TIMELY NOTIFICATION BULLETIN
Possible Threat to the Community
"Your Right to Know"
October 8, 2012

In compliance with the "Timely Notice" provisions of the federal Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act of 1998, Campus Security is giving notice of an act of violence reported to have occurred in the area of Chaplain Lane and Fort Street Mall on 10-8-12 at 8:45 pm.

REPORTED OFFENSE: An HPU student was in the area of Chaplain Lane and Fort Street Mall on 10-8-12 at 8:45 pm, when struck unexpectedly from behind. It appears a struggle was over a moped owned by the student. The suspect and victim struggled briefly before the suspect ran from the scene on foot. No property was taken, but the victim sustained injuries. The suspect is described as medium height, thin build, wearing a dark shirt and jeans. The suspect was wearing a black hat which was pulled down over his face. Suspect had dark facial hair.

Be cognizant of your surroundings and if anything suspicious, please report to HPU security or the Honolulu Police Department.

Honolulu Police Department has been contacted and an Attempted Robbery investigation has been initiated. HPU Security was not informed of the incident until 10-12-12.
