

TIMELY NOTIFICATION BULLETIN
Possible Threat to the Community
"Your Right to Know"
October 30, 2012

In compliance with the "Timely Notice" provisions of the federal Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act of 1998, Campus Security is giving notice of a possible stalker in the area of the LB Building, 1060 Fort Street Mall.

REPORTED OFFENSE: On 9-20-12 at 1535 hours, an HPU female student felt she was followed by an unknown male. A security report was filed and HPU Security was on alert for male. On 10-1-12 at 0937 hours, a male matching the description tried to enter the LB Building, 1060 Fort Street, following female students. The male was stopped by security, was identified and a picture was obtained. HPU Security is working with LB Security and Law Enforcement on this matter. The male is described as 6'3", 140 lbs, very slim build, gray hair, beard and moustache. Male is in his 60s, usually wears black pants, black shoes and a black shirt. Sometimes this particular male will change his shirt to a bright color.

HPU Security and Fort Street Mall Security were able to identify suspect male and have been monitoring his activity in the Fort Street Mall area. On 10-29-12, same male suspect followed a female into the UPS Store at 1060 Bishop Street. HPU Security and Building Security detained male. The suspect male was arrested for an outstanding warrant by the Honolulu Police Department and trespass warned from HPU LB Building.

HPU Security is working with the prosecutor's office to possibly have suspect male issued a stay away order from the Fort Street Mall via the District Court.

Be cognizant of your surroundings and if anything suspicious, please report to HPU security or the Honolulu Police Department.
