

TIMELY NOTIFICATION BULLETIN
Possible Threat to the Community
"Your Right to Know"
September 5, 2012

In compliance with the "Timely Notice" provisions of the federal Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act of 1998, Campus Security is giving notice of an act of violence reported to have occurred in the area of Kukui Street and Aala Street on 9-5-12 at 8:30 pm.

REPORTED OFFENSE: A group of Hawaii Pacific University students were walking on Kukui Street toward Aala Street, when approached by three males. One male suspect tried to pick a fight with the students. The same male pulled a knife in attempt to commit robbery. The students left the area quickly on foot. No property taken, No injuries reported. The other two suspects stood by, watched the incident. The main suspect is described as Micronesian or Filipino, 18-19 years old, 5-6, 140 lbs., black hair, blue shirt, and unknown color shorts wearing a blue bandana. The second male suspect is described as Micronesian or Filipino, in his early 20s, white t shirt, long pants. The description of the third male suspect is unclear.

Be cognizant of your surroundings and if anything suspicious, please report to HPU security or the Honolulu Police Department.

Honolulu Police Department has been contacted and an Attempted Robbery investigation has been initiated.
