Title: Average Credit Overload Per Full-time Faculty

Term(s): 1998-1999 Academic Year thru 2002-2003 Academic Year

Description: This table identifies the average number of credit overload completed by full-time faculty per academic year.

Analysis: Overall there has been a 32.7% decrease to 4.67 in total average credit overload per full-time faculty between the 1998-1999 and 2002-2003 Academic Years. The College of Business Administration saw the largest drop at 60.1% between the same two Academic Years while the College of International Studies has the least percentage drop at 11.2%.

Overall there are more full-time faculty members on staff and decreasing number of overload credits assigned.

Title: Fall 2003 Course Enrollment Information by Adjunct and Full-time Faculty

Term(s): Fall 2003

Description: This table identifies the number and percent of sections taught by adjunct faculty in comparison to full-time faculty. The data, which includes enrollment numbers, are sorted by division and course level.

Analysis: Overall, 34.3% (n=1,086) of sections offered during the Fall 2003 term were taught by adjunct faculty members. The 40.5% (n=556) of adjunct faculty teaching lower-division sections is greater than those taught by adjunct faculty in the upper-division (30.4%; n=401) and graduate sections (19.4%; n=129).

The School of Nursing had the highest percentage of adjunct faculty sections with 45.2% (n=168) while the Professional Studies Division had the lowest with 17.8% (n=45). However, College of Liberal Arts offered the most number of sections taught by adjunct faculty with 86 of the total 279.

Title: Fall 2003 Course Enrollment Information by Adjunct and Full-time Faculty

Term(s): Summer Term IV 2003, Fall 2003, Military Campus Term I 2004

Description: This table identifies the number and percent of sections taught by adjunct faculty in comparison to full-time faculty. The data, which includes enrollment numbers, are arranged by division and course level.

Analysis: Overall, 42.4% (n=1,465) of the sections offered over the Fall 2003 terms were taught by adjunct faculty members. The 47.9% (n=780) of adjunct faculty teaching lower-division sections is greater than those taught by adjunct faculty in the upper-division (39.9%; n=542) and graduate sections (2.1%; n=143).

The Military Campus Division had a higher percentage of adjunct faculty sections with 76.8% (n=248) followed by the Communication Division with 49.5% (n=97) of those offered. The Professional Studies Division had the lowest percentage with 22.4% (n=79) adjunct faculty sections offered.

Analysis: Overall, 49.2% (n=1,086) of sections offered were taught by faculty members with a Masters degree while 49.3% had a Doctorate. Within the lower-division, 56.1% (n=556) of sections offered were taught by faculty with a Masters degree while 64.3% (n=129) of Graduate division sections were taught by faculty with Doctorate degrees.
