Title: Spring 2003 Course Enrollment Information by Adjunct and Full-time Faculty

Term(s): Spring 200320

Description: This table identifies the number and percent of sections taught by adjunct faculty in comparison to full-time faculty. The data, which includes enrollment numbers, are sorted by division and course level.

Analysis: Overall, 29.7% (n=1,131) of sections offered during the Spring 2003 term were taught by adjunct faculty members. The 32.7% (n=498) of adjunct faculty teaching lower-division sections is greater than those taught by adjunct faculty in the upper-division (31.7%; n=458) and graduate sections (16.0%; n=175).

The Communication Division had the highest percentage of adjunct faculty sections with 43.5% (n=85) while the Professional Studies Division had the lowest with 15.3% (n=72). However, Business Administration offered the most number of sections taught by adjunct faculty with 101 of the total 259.

Term(s): Winter 200295, Military Campus Term II 200310, Spring 200320

Description: This table identifies the number and percent of sections taught by adjunct faculty in comparison to full-time faculty. The data, which includes enrollment numbers, are arranged by division and course level.

Analysis: Overall, 36.9% (n=1,446) of the sections offered over the Spring 2003 terms were taught by adjunct faculty members. The 42.2% (n=658) of adjunct faculty teaching lower-division sections is greater than those taught by adjunct faculty in the upper-division (37.6%; n=598) and graduate sections (15.8%; n=190).

The Military Campus Division had a higher percentage of adjunct faculty sections with 69.2% (n=253) followed by the Communication Division with 42.7% (n=89) of those offered. The Professional Studies Division had the lowest percentage with 15.4% (n=78) adjunct faculty sections offered.

Analysis: Overall, 50% (n=1,131) of sections offered were taught by faculty members with a Masters degree while 48.3% had a Doctorate. Within the lower-division, 57.6% (n=498) of sections offered were taught by faculty with a Masters degree while 68.6% (n=175) of Graduate division sections were taught by faculty with Doctorate degrees.

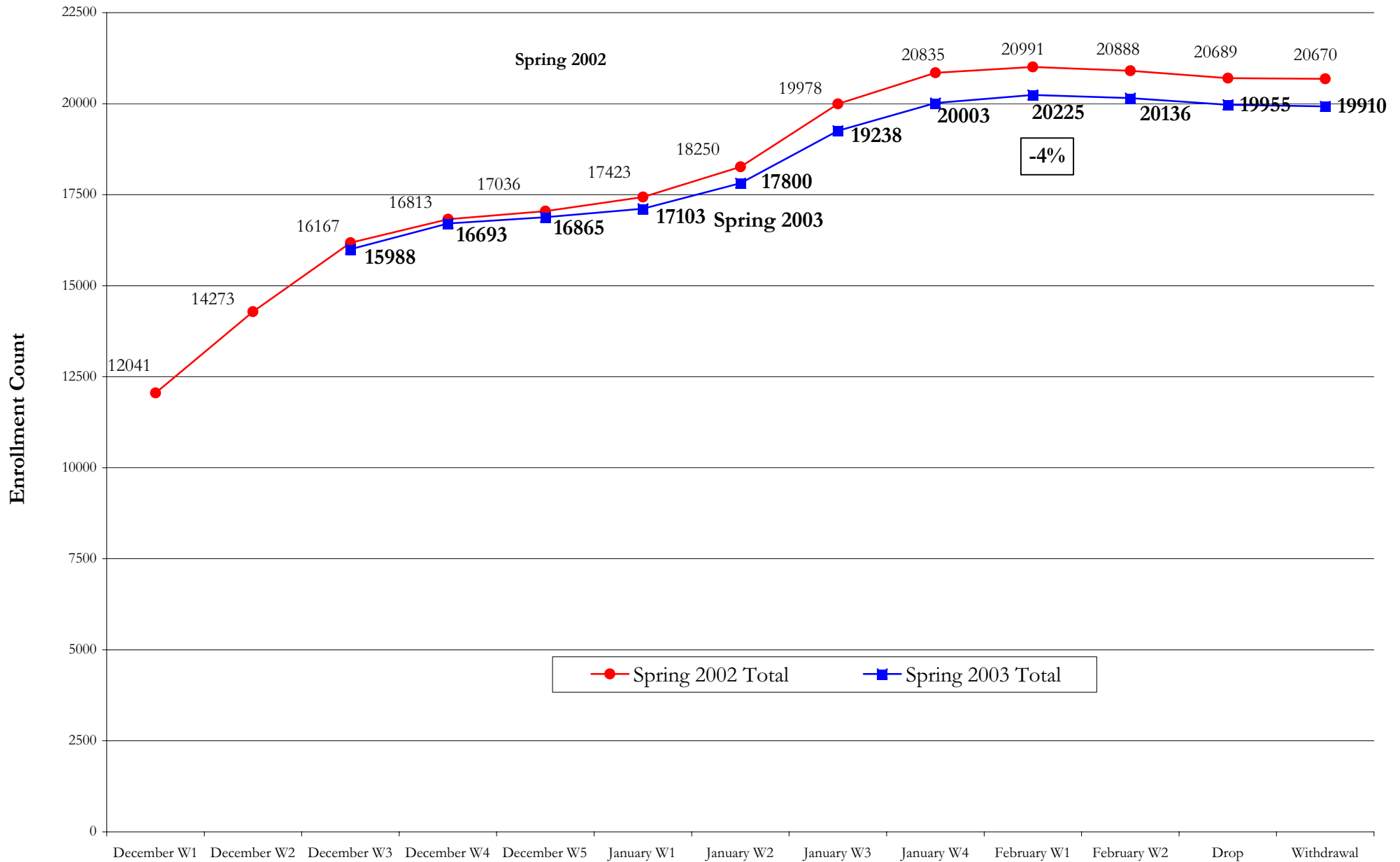

Spring 2002 and 2003 Total Enrollment Comparison

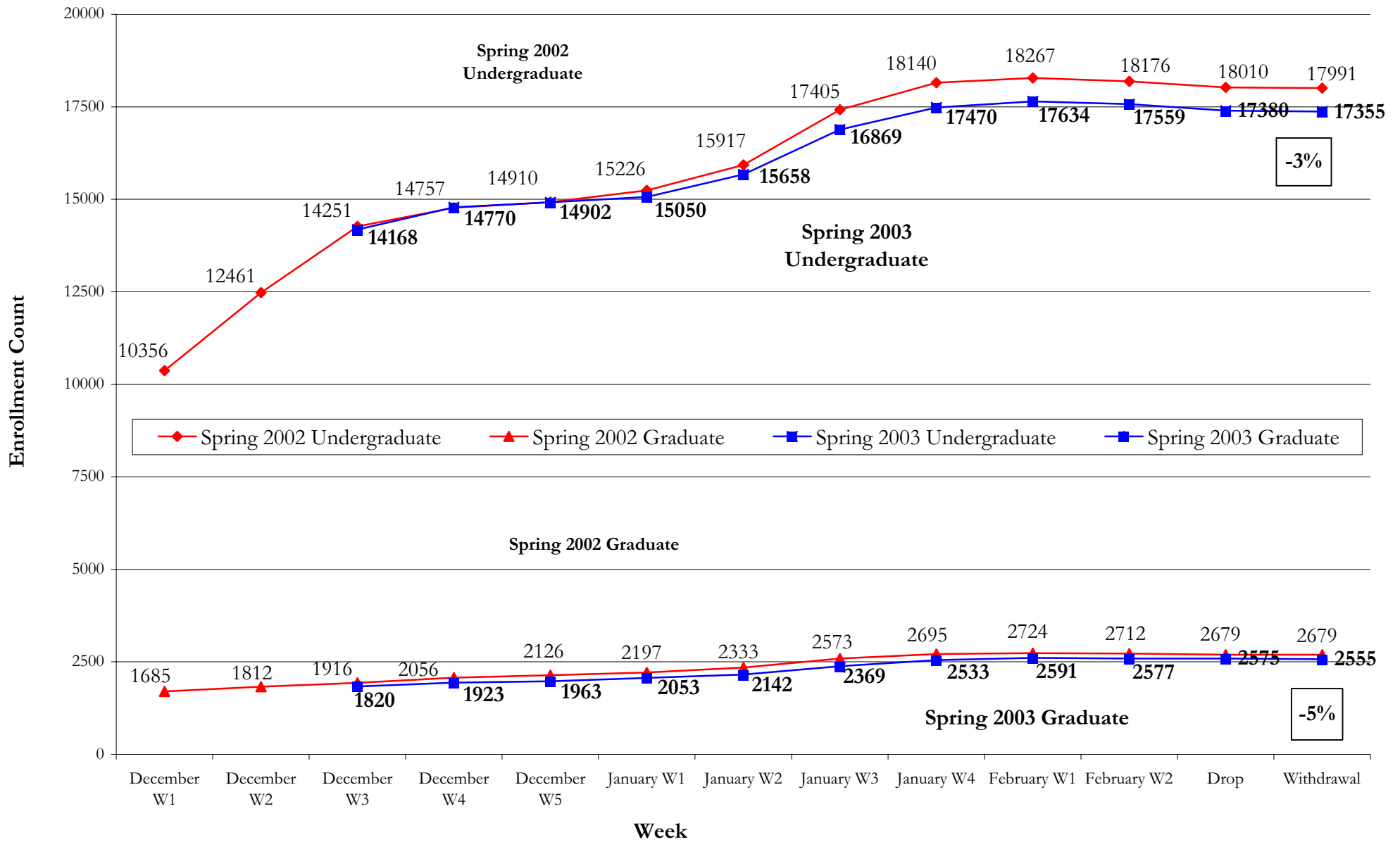
