Description:	This table identifies the average number of credit overload completed by full-time faculty per academic year. The data are broken down by division and academic area. Totals by division are available.
Summary:	<p>Overall, there are more full-time faculty members on staff and a decrease in overload credits assigned.</p> <p>Overall, there has been a 23.0% decrease to 4.12 in total average credit overload per full-time faculty between the 1999-2000 and 2003-2004 Academic Years. For that period, the Center for English Language Programs saw the largest average credit overload percentage decrease with 78.1%, while the School of Nursing had the smallest percentage decrease with 9.6%. All departments recorded average percentage decreases in credit overloads assigned in comparison to the 1999-2000 Academic Year.</p>

Summary:	<p>Overall, 30.6% (n=1,223) of the sections offered in the Fall 2004 term were taught by adjunct faculty members. Lower division courses had the highest percentage of sections taught by adjunct faculty with 36.8% (n=593), followed by upper division courses with 30.0% (n=454) and graduate courses with 11.4% (n=176).</p> <p>The College of Communication had the highest percentage of sections taught by adjunct faculty with 39.8% (n=103), while the College of Natural Sciences had the lowest percentage with 20.2% (n=119).</p>

Summary:	<p>Overall, 39.7% (n=1,595) of the sections offered in the Fall 2004 term were taught by adjunct faculty members. Lower division courses had the highest percentage of sections taught by adjunct faculty with 45.8% (n=803), followed by upper division courses with 39.8% (n=601) and graduate courses with 14.1% (n=191).</p> <p>Military Campus Programs had the highest percentage of sections taught by adjunct faculty with 79.3% (n=241), followed by the Center for English Language Programs with 48.1% (n=81) and the College of Communication with 40.4% (n=114). The College of Professional Studies had the lowest percentage of sections taught by adjunct faculty with 22.1% (n=104).</p>
