In compliance with the "Timely Notice" provisions of the federal Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act of 1998, Campus Security is giving notice of an act of a suspicious circumstance in the area of Fort Street Mall

REPORTED OFFENSE: Security at the LB Building, 1060 Bishop Street noted a suspicious male attempting to follow a HPU female student into the building. Security immediately stopped male and tried to summon police. Male left on foot on Bishop Street. The male is described as Asian, 25-30 years old, black shoulder length hair, black moustache and beard, 5-6, 150 lbs., . Male was wearing a blue t shirt with "I Love Hawaii", blue baseball cap, blue and white surf shorts, and slippers. HPU Security is aware of the male and will attempt to identify. This RAVE ALERT is to remind students, faculty and staff to be cognizant of your surroundings and if anything suspicious, please report to HPU security or the Honolulu Police Department. It is safe to attend functions in a buddy system and to look after each other.
