In compliance with the "Timely Notice" provisions of the federal Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act of 1998, Campus Security is giving notice of suspicious activity in the area.

**REPORTED OFFENSE: On Thursday, February 28<sup>th</sup> at 8:23 a.m., a woman was walking up Aloha Tower Drive towards Ala Moana Blvd when two unknown dark skinned males attempted to rob her.**

**One male distracted her while the other male rode up on a bike behind her and tried to take her purse.**

**When they were unsuccessful the males fled up Bishop Street.**
