<u>REPORTED OFFENSE:</u> On Tuesday, March 19th at 12 p.m., HPU Security was called to investigate a report that a man was sleeping in front of the HPU Shuttle Stop at Kukui and Beretania. Upon the officer's arrival, the male pushed the security officer and was provoking the officer to fight. The male left and headed to the adjacent park. HPD was called but did not arrest the male. The male was described as dark skinned, black curly hair and approximately 5' 10" and 155-160 pounds, wearing grey-colored shorts and no shirt with bare feet.
