Test Scores	Minimum composite score of 70th percentile on the <u>Test of Essential Academic Skills</u> (TEAS*). • A valid TEAS is one that was taken no longer than 2 years ago from the date your admission application is submitted. • You may take the TEAS test a maximum of 3 times within the 2 years. If the maximum is exceeded within the 2-year period the highest among the first 3 tests will be used. • A 14 day waiting period in between tests is needed. • We will accept the highest TEAS score within the parameters mentioned above.		
GPA Requirements	 Have a minimum all colleges attended cumulative GPA of 3.0. Have an overall nursing prerequisite GPA of 3.0 (must receive a C or better in prerequisite courses) 		
Prerequisite Courses	 Complete all prerequisite courses* no later than the semester prior to the start of the nursing program. Applicants with no more than two (2) outstanding prerequisites at time of application will be considered. A combination of science lecture and science lab is regarded as one (1) outstanding course. You must be currently enrolled in the outstanding prerequisite courses at the time of application. 		
General Education Courses	 Priority consideration will be given to applicants with no more than one (1) outstanding general education requirement at the start of the Nursing program. It is highly recommended to complete all general education courses before entry into the nursing program. There is no available time to take general education courses alongside the nursing courses with the exception of the summer. It is recommended to apply early so that your transcripts are evaluated for transfer credit before the deadline. Students that are accepted to the BSN program may be denied their seat because their courses do not transfer to HPU. Use the transfer credit library to search www.hpu.edu/transfercredit 		
Transcripts	 Official transcripts for <u>all</u> college coursework taken outside of HPU is <u>required</u> for the Nursing program prior to the start of the program. Applicants that submit official transcripts will have priority consideration. Unofficial transcripts must have the schools name, address, and insignia. 		
Recommendations	 Two professional letters of reference such as from employers, faculty and other professional contacts. Personal letters of reference from family members or friends are not acceptable. The applicant will provide the references' contact information in the HPU Nursing application, the computer will send an email to the contact to complete. In case of technical difficulties with the online system, you may have the letter of recommendation sent directly to the HPU Admissions office BSNadmissions@hpu.edu The applicant is responsible for making sure the letters of recommendation have been submitted. Personal Statement	A personal statement (500 word limit) that answers the following questions: a) Why do you want to become a nurse? b) What are your educational goals? c) Why did you choose to apply to HPU?
