Competitive Application Pathway	
Pathway Option For	<p>Current HPU Nursing majors taking prerequisites and general education, not yet in upper division BSN level 1 courses <u>and</u> entering Transfer students.</p> <p>Admission is competitive and based upon remaining seats available after HPU student guaranteed pathway progression requests have been completed. Meeting of the minimum requirements <u>does not</u> guarantee admission into upper division Level 1 Nursing.</p>
Overall Minimum Cumulative GPA	Minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA (all earned college credit) or higher at time of progression request
Minimum BSN Pre-requisite GPA	Minimum 3.0 or higher GPA in BSN prerequisite courses (all earned college credit), with all grades C or higher at time of progression request, and no more than two (2) prerequisite courses in progress. (A&P + Lab together count as 1 course)
Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS)	<p>Completion of Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) Entrance Test with the minimum overall and sub-section scores:</p> <p>-Minimum Overall Total Score: 70%</p>
Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) Valid Scores Information	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - TEAS must be within 2 years of progression request deadline - 3 maximum TEAS attempts within the 2 year timeframe - Minimum 14 day waiting period in-between tests is required - Highest valid TEAS score report will be accepted
Letters of Rec	Two (2) Professional Letters of Recommendation
Personal Statement	<p>Personal Statement (Maximum 500 words)</p> <p>Answer the following questions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Why do you want to be a nurse? • What are your educational goals? • Why did you choose to apply to HPU?
General Education	Priority consideration given to applicants who have all General Education courses either completed, or in progress at time of application. No more than 4 GE courses remaining by start of BSN upper division Level 1 courses.
Repeated Courses	BSN prerequisite courses taken at HPU in which one earns a grade below C may be eligible for "grade forgiveness" as defined by the HPU Course Repeat Policy. Maximum of 12 credits.
Other	<p>No prior nursing program dismissal.</p> <p>All official transcripts for course work taken outside of HPU must be received at time of progression request.</p>
Fall Deadline	15-Feb (Priority) & 1-Apr (Secondary)
Fall Decision Notification	15-Mar (Priority) & 1-May (Secondary)
Spring Deadline	1-Oct
Spring Decision Notification	1-Nov
