WRI 3510 is an introduction to the theory and practice of teaching writing to others. Students learn strategies for tutoring writers one-on-one and in small groups. The course combines 2 hours a week of lecture/discussion with four hours per week of tutoring experience in the WRI 1101 labs. This course deals with instruction in both settings: what students learn about tutoring writing in 3510 is juxtaposed against the writing class setting and with students' experiences as a tutor and writer.

In addition to earning credit for the course, students are paid for the hours they tutor in the lab.
