

CONTACTING YOUR ADVISOR

- Best way to contact your Advisor is via email
- Always provide your HPU ID number
- If requesting assistance with registration, provide the following:
 - Semester (Fall/Spring/Summer)
 - Course information (alpha, number, CRN), Example MGMT 6002 CRN 4427
 - If requesting HYBRID sections, must mention you are military/veteran student. Emails will be forwarded to Registrar's Office for assistance with registration
- Petition to Graduate (PTG) Audit might require a meeting (in-person or Zoom)
- About the Elective
 - After registration, if the course is not listed on CORE courses (Degree Works), request a petition to be filed on your behalf (for the course to be considered your Program Approved Elective). This should be done BEFORE last semester ends.

- Fall, Spring and Summer Entry
 - Each semester is divided into sessions A and B (8-week accelerated courses)
- Courses offered in-person, online, and hybrid
 - Hybrid courses created to support full time status for military/veteran students

MBA ACCELERATED

Our MBA Accelerated program is a 32-credit program, with flexible course options offered in accelerated 8-week terms. Students can mix and match based on interests or work schedules.

MBA+

Our MBA+ program allows you to add an HPU Graduate Certificate to get a deep dive in an area of emphasis. After completing your first semester, specialize your degree in courses ranging from Business Analytics to Nonprofit Management.

MBA COURSES

- Consider the **Recommended Plan** for Fall, Spring and Summer Entry (see "Program Fact Sheet" posted on MBA website)
- If taking courses "out of order"
 - Currently, no prerequisites for 6000-level courses
 - 7000-level courses should be taken at the end (last semester); exceptions can be considered.
- The Elective: Pick an elective according to your interests, background, preferences; choose courses that will support your future career goals. Our MBA graduates will apply for new positions, change jobs, open their own business in different industries, etc. Each student needs to find courses that would work for them. Any 6000-level offered at HPU could work. Explore courses from other master programs and certificates. Some of the courses may have prerequisites that could be waived. Some restrictions apply (must see course restrictions posted)
