### THE COURSE

Hawai'i Pacific University's *Economics for Hawai'i Teachers* course will explain the causes of important economic phenomena around us such as inflation, Hawaii's high housing costs, and the effects of Hawaiian economic policies both contemporary and historical, and provides guidance and continuing support for educators of all subjects and grade levels to bring age-appropriate economics content into their classrooms.

This live online course is produced in collaboration with the Hawai'i Council on Economic Education (HCEE), and is aligned with the Hawai'i Core Standards in Social Studies (HCSSS). Completion of the course provides three (3) graduate-level credits in education (ED) that count towards **HIDOE Salary Schedule Reclassification**. The course can be completed either synchronously (recommended) or semi-asynchronously by reviewing the class recordings posted each week, and runs eight weeks 5:15–8:15pm on Tuesdays, June 8th–July 28th, 2026.

### TUITION AND SCHOLARSHIP

A full scholarship will be provided to all Hawai'i public and private school teachers of all subjects and all grade levels PreK-12 & adults, as well as part-time teachers, educational officers, and educational assistants. All application fees will also be waived, and no textbooks or other course materials are required for purchase.

The coursework consists of; (i) creating an original lesson plan in a group—feel free to invite colleagues to join this course so you can work together, (ii) quizzes, and (iii) a final exam; there is no Learning Results Portfolio.
