WHEN TO APPLY

Please refer to the attached Special Enrollment Period guide for information about when to apply for coverage. Note that you must have your application fully completed and submitted (along with payment) by the 15th of the month prior to the month when you want your coverage to begin.

If you need to enroll outside of open enrollment, you may do so if you have experienced a triggering event. For example, if you lose eligibility for your current health plan or you move into our service area - both possible triggering events - you may qualify for a special enrollment period. Important information for completing your application:

- Please make sure you review the deadlines for enrolling in coverage. You must have your application fully completed and submitted (along with payment) by the 15th of the month prior to the month when you want your coverage to begin.
- The residential address you provide in your application must be in Hawaii* and must not be a P.O. Box.
- You may enter a temporary Hawaii address, however you must contact both HPU and Kaiser Permanente immediately when your address is updated.

3. Select your payment method

Payment for your first month's coverage by checking or savings account, debit card, or credit card is **required** to be submitted together with your application.
