Pathway Option For	<p>Current HPU Nursing majors taking pre-requisites and general education, not yet in upper division BSN Clinical Level courses.</p> <p>Admission via guaranteed progression pathway is for current HPU students that submit their progression request and meet <b>all</b> of the criteria below. Seats in the upper division program are limited; therefore, we reserve the right to defer a student's progression request if capacity of the most immediate entry term has been reached.</p>
Overall Minimum Cumulative GPA	Minimum 3.5 cumulative GPA (all earned college credit) or higher at time of progression request
BSN Minimum Pre-requisite GPA	Minimum 3.6 or higher GPA in BSN prerequisite courses (all earned college credit), with all grades C or higher at time of progression request, and no more than two prerequisite courses in progress. (A&P + Lab together count as 1 course)
Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS)	<p>Completion of Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) Entrance Test must meet all of the minimum overall and minimum sub-section scores:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Overall 76%</li> <li>- Reading sub-section 80%</li> <li>- Math sub-section 80%</li> <li>- Science sub-section 65%</li> <li>English &amp; Language sub-section 80%</li> </ul>
Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) Valid Scores Information	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- TEAS must be within 2 years of progression request deadline</li> <li>- 3 maximum TEAS attempts within the 2 year period</li> <li>- Minimum 14 day waiting period in-between tests is required</li> <li>Highest valid TEAS score report will be accepted</li> </ul>

Repeated Courses	BSN prerequisite courses may be repeated only once for the purpose of improving the grade. Per the HPU Course Repeat Policy, only grades initially earned below a C may be eligible for “grade forgiveness”. If a course is repeated twice, the highest of the first two grades will be considered. Maximum of 12 credits.
Other	<p>Minimum 12 completed, or currently in progress credits at HPU at time of progression request. No prior nursing program dismissal.</p> <p>All official transcripts for course work taken outside of HPU must be received at time of progression request</p>

Seats in the upper division program are limited; therefore, we reserve the right to defer a student's progression request if capacity of the most immediate entry term has been reached.</b>
<b>Overall Minimum Cumulative GPA</b>	Maintain a minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA each semester
<b>BSN Minimum Pre-requisite GPA</b>	Complete all nursing pre-requisite coursework with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.5
<b>Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS)</b>	Waived
<b>Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) Valid Scores Information</b>	Waived
<b>Letters of Rec</b>	Waived
<b>Personal Statement</b>	Waived
<b>General Education</b>	All general education courses must be completed or currently in progress at time of progression request
<b>Pre-requisites</b>	All pre-requisite coursework completed
<b>Repeated Courses</b>	BSN prerequisite courses may be repeated only once for the purpose of improving the grade. Per the Course Repeat Policy, only grades initially earned below a C may be eligible for "grade forgiveness". If a course is repeated twice, the highest of the first two grades will be considered. Maximum of 12 credits
<b>Other</b>	Engage in Nursing Scholar activities and NUR 3999 course during Freshman Year  Continuous full-time enrollment  All official transcripts for course work taken outside of HPU must be received at time of progression request
