

# I-94 Travel Record


The I-94 document is very important. It has 2 main purposes:

- Entry and exit record: It shows when you enter the U.S. and when you leave.
- Immigration status: It shows your immigration status based on your visa. Most international students have F-1 status, and this means you must follow the rules for F-1 students.

You get an I-94 **each time you enter the U.S.** When you leave the U.S., that I-94 ends. Every new entry gives you a new I-94 number.

## How to view your I-94:

1. Using any web browser, type “I-94” in the search bar and select the first result.
  - a. NOTE: The I-94 may take 24-48 hours to update on the USCBP website AFTER you arrive in the U.S.




2. Click on “Get Most Recent I-94/I-95”

3. Review the Terms of Service and click on “I Acknowledge and Agree”



4. Enter your information **exactly as shown on your passport** (name, date of birth, passport number, and country of citizenship). After your record is found, print the form for your records.
